Meeting called to order at 3:01 PM

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Matt Heins moved to approve the minutes from the January 12, 2016 regular board meeting. Don Hatler seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

REPORTS

Staff Reports

Meghan Adamire reported on site visits and recent dairy inspections at Willow-Wist and Maple View farms. Meghan announced that she is working jointly with Kitsap and Jefferson conservation districts on a spring pasture workshop that will be offered in all 3 counties. She also reported on plant sale activities, noting that over 16,500 plants have been sold.

Jennifer Bond reported that there was not much activity with PIC implementation in January. Jennifer attended a Sequim High School FFA meeting where discussed writing farm plans with the parents of two of the families that have livestock at the FFA farm. She will continue to try and reach out to the other FFA families.

Joe Holtrop reported that the Hendrickson to McComb Rd. piping project is nearly complete and that he has been very impressed with the contractor – Strider Construction Co., Inc. Joe also reported that the facilitator working with Agnew Irrigation District and the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe on the McDonald Creek irrigation diversion project has indicated that efforts will be limited to working on improving the fish passage at the diversion dam.

More activities for the month can be found in the attached Conservation District Staff Report.

NRCS Report

Jim introduced his new supervisor, Sarah Tanuvasa, at the beginning of the meeting (she was only able to stay for the introduction). Jim reported on current forestry contracts that he is working on.

Treasurer's Report

Ben Smith moved to approve the January 2016 Treasurer's report and approve for payment electronic funds transfers and checks described as FF 9064-9091 dated January 1-31, 2016 in the amount of \$167,496.35. Matt Heins seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

The Board discussed investing up to \$150,000 in Certificates of Deposit to take advantage of current promotional rates that are higher than usual. The Board generally agreed that a laddering approach would be best.

Don Hatler moved to invest \$50,000 in a 24 month Certificate of Deposit with First Federal, at a rate of 1.51%. Matt Heins seconded.

Discussion: Ben Smith felt that interest rates will keep rising and therefore would rather invest only \$25,000 at this time.

Motion approved with four ayes and one nay.

Announcements/Public Comment

OLD BUSINESS

Interlocal Agreement with Sequim Prairie-Tri Irrigation Association for Ditch Piping.

Joe distributed a draft agreement and described the project, which is scheduled for construction in the fall.

Ben Smith moved to approve the Interlocal Agreement between Clallam CD and Sequim Prairie-Tri Irrigation

Association for independent M-1 ditch piping. Matt Heins seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

NACD Annual Meeting Report

Matt Heins and Joe Holtrop attended the meeting in Reno. Joe attended to give a presentation and Matt attended to represent the District at a session on tribal partnerships. Matt felt that their presence was appreciated by the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe. Joe is planning on doing a press release to recognize the tribe's partnership with the District.

Joe informed the Board that his expenses for the trip exceeded the approved amount of \$500.

Ben Smith moved to approve up to an additional \$250 of retroactive expenses for Joe Holtrop's costs to attend the NACD Annual Meeting. Don Hatler seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Cultural Resources Unanticipated Discovery Plan Approval

Joe Holtrop distributed a draft plan and procedures based on a template created by Larry Brewer of the Washington Conservation Commission. The Board reviewed and Joe made a couple of corrections.

Ben Smith moved to approve the Cultural Resources Unanticipated Discovery Plan, as amended. Matt Heins seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

Contract Cultural Resource Consultants for Cultural Resources Survey Services

Joe Holtrop stated that he sought estimates for cultural resources survey services from the Lower Elwha Tribe's cultural resources specialist and from Cultural Resource Consultants, based out of Bainbridge Island for three upcoming projects. The Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe is no longer offering these services to non-tribe entities. Joe Holtrop recommended using Cultural Resource Consultants as they offered the best price and were more responsive.

Ben Smith moved to approve a contract with Cultural Resource Consultants for Cultural Resources survey services for two upcoming irrigation projects with Agnew Irrigation District and Sequim Prairie-Tri Irrigation Association and an aquifer recharge project with Agnew Irrigation District. Matt Heins seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

Annual Interlocal Agreement with Clallam County Approval

Ben Smith moved to approve the Interlocal Agreement between Clallam CD and Clallam County for annual funding in the amount of \$26,000. Robert Beebe seconded. Motion approved unanimously.
