#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Matt Heins moved to approve the minutes from the February 9, 2016 regular board meeting. Don Hatler seconded. Motion approved unanimously.

#### REPORTS

#### **Staff Reports**

Meghan Adamire gave a plant sale re-cap and reported on the status of the Adams FFFPP project and various CREP planting projects.

Jennifer Bond reported on recent site visits to landowners dealing with mud issues and the status of the PIC Implementation project. The County will be sending a postcard to residents in the Meadowbrook/Golden Sands area regarding the County's rebate program for onsite septic system inspections. The County agreed to include a statement regarding our on-site septic system repair/replacement cost-share program that Jennifer will provide. The Board requested that Jennifer also pursue more aggressive promotion of our program, including sending a mailer to all residents in the PIC Pilot Project area.

Joe Holtrop reported on the WACD Legislative Days meetings with our state legislators. Joe also reported on a recent meeting with newly elected Commissioner Ozias, which included a tour of Golden Sands. Joe has been asked to continue as a permanent member of the Puget Sound Partnership's Shellfish Strategic Initiative Team. The Board agreed that this is fine as long as Joe's expenses continue to be covered.

NRCS Report

Jim Poffel reported that the preliminary ranking for 2016 EQIP projects is complete and that 4 out of 6 applications submitted in Clallam County were accepted – all were forestry related. There might be another EQIP sign-up this spring, geared towards salmon.
